Mayor's Report

In February the City is purchasing a new application known as 911 Cellular. This app will be free to Mayfield Heights Residents and allows safety forces to respond faster to your location. When connected to Wi-Fi it will show your exact location. Users will also have the ability to report issues, suspicious activity. It also has a notification know as Friend Watch which will allow the user to notify up to three people when you leave for a run or such, approx. time you will be gone and when you return.

Chick-fil-A opened for business and has hired 110 staff members. They have already become involved in the community and will continue to grow that involvement.

TLCI group meet on January 15. This group, through a grant, is assisting with the development of a bike/walk path plan. There will be a second public meeting at the Ross DeJohn Community Center on February 6 at 7 pm.

The Service Department has magnet available for the 2019 Recycling schedule to pick up from their department or at City Hall.
