Mayor DiCicco reported a follow up on the Your911 cellular app. It is officially up and running. The app will also include the ability to allow responders to find your exact location, even inside a building, if you have your location finder enabled on your smart phone. Ms. Rogaliner will forward the email shared by the Mayor to City Hall Staff.

Gold Resident applications are now available for residents who have resided in Mayfield Heights for 50+ years. Applications are located at the Community Center or City Hall. Mayor DiCicco encouraged the Commission to share this opportunity with anyone they know who may qualify.
