REPORT OF MAYOR

Mayor DiCicco no report, absent.

REPORT OF RECREATION DIRECTOR

Mr. Ward gave an update on the bunny for Saturday, March 27. There are 47 kids and 57 adults, which will be 18 tables. Set up will begin at 7:30 am as we have a lot to do. He is tentative about setting anything up the night before. Mrs. Moses and Mrs. Rogaliner will be finishing the shopping tomorrow. The meal for the adults will be a large muffin, fruit, and a water. The kids will receive a basket with a craft, small muffin packet, yogurt, juice, and fruit. The egg hunt will occur on the tennis courts in the event of the field at Dragga being to wet. The Bunny photo will be played by ear, if it is not too wet, the plan is to have the picture at the Gazebo. Wristbands will be handed out to identify the participants from those just hanging out in the park. Mr. Ward thanked Mrs. Sipos and Mrs. Moses for helping with stuffing the eggs.

Summer plans are in the works, Mr. Ward is hopeful that we can have Unity Days as the restrictions are updated. The office is working on the small details, so we are prepared. The event may look different than past years, but he feels people are ready to get back to a sense of normalcy which Unity Days can provide. The main challenge will be securing the number of volunteers we may need for this year. The event is planned for June 25- 27. It will be determined if having two or three days will be best for the current guidelines.

The office will be in a mad dash to pull everything together for camps, pool and special events.

REPORT OF COUNCIL MEMBER DON MANNO

Mr. Manno reported that the last council meeting was very productive. The final approval for McDonald's and the remodel is expected to be done by June 1. Krispie Cream is also approved and will include a production facility for the eastside of Cleveland and include a drive thru and

dining area. Construction expected to begin soon. A Dental Clinic is going in on Cedar Road. An ordinance was finalized for the new car corridor. This will include Ganley and the Ford locations. Mr. Manno said that the renewal for SWAT was approved. Mayland is coming along, and negotiations are going on. The entrance to the plaza will line-up with the light at Mayfield Ridge. No formal design has been submitted and only a rendering has been presented as to what the possibilities are for the property. Demolition of the remaining building will begin after the deli has moved.

An ordinance was passed for 5 intersection enhancements to increase pedestrian safety. Mr. Manno also said that bids for the Gates Mills Blvd resurfacing from SOM to Cedar will be coming in. Also the bridge under pass on Marsol is moving along. These improvements will help with pedestrian safety as well.

Mr. Manno concluded his report by saying a lot is happening in our city.
