

**CITY OF MAYFIELD HEIGHTS**  
**SENIOR SUBCOMMITTEE**  
**April 27, 2021**

The monthly meeting of the Senior Subcommittee was called to order at 3:55 p.m. by Recreation Director Sean Ward.

Mayor's Report

Mayor DiCicco no report; absent.

Recreation Director's Report

Director Ward reported that we are making plans for summer, including Unity Days! He noted that in 2020 we had to submit a report to the board of health for events and programs, that is not the case for 2021. That being said, the current guidelines are very vague, and Director Ward is working with our board of health representative to make sure our plans are complying with them.

Director Ward is planning for a parade this summer. The step off location will not be the Greens of Lyndhurst this year due to the space being used to store cars for a local dealership. He is working with the owners of Mayland to see if we can step off from here this year. At this time, the owners have purchased the gas well and have no plans in place at this time for digging until late July.

Director Ward shared that the department is working on other events as well. These include new Lunch-n-Concert series. The plans include having two seating times, with 50 per. Silver Shooters, Pickleball, and two bus trips will be offered. It was decided that the Gold Resident Lunch will not occur this year, since it is the most vulnerable age group. Director Ward stressed that we are working on plans that bring activities back in the safest way possible.

Old Business

Director Ward answered a few questions about the pool and park plans. The City has approved an owner's representative from our City Engineer firm. An advertisement for architecture firm bids has been placed. Once the deadline has passed the applicants will be narrowed down to 3- 4 for interviews. Once the firm is secured plans will be developed. If things remain on schedule this should be finalized by June. Director Ward shared the preliminary plans with the group and shared that the current timeline has groundbreaking would happen in May of 2022 and ribbon cutting in May 2023.

Director Ward recapped the concert plans for Mrs. Blair. Each concert will have 50 per time reservations. Preregistration and payment of the \$5 fee is required. Our sponsors will provide either water, light snack (chips) or dessert. The City will provide the main lunch item. Staff will sanitize in between each seating. All current pandemic guidelines will be in practice.
